K3 Robotics Lesson

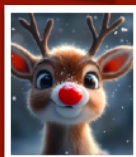

MONTHLY ACTIVITY : REINDEER WREATH

Materials Needed:

- Brown & Red Crepe Papers
- Paper plate
- Brown paint
- Black & white stickers
- Scissors & a paintbrush
- Glue
- Construction paper (light color)



1. Cut a hole in the center of a paper plate.
2. Crumple and glue brown crepe paper all over the plate.
3. Paint your hands with brown paint, make handprints on construction paper, let them dry, and cut them out.
4. Glue the handprints at the top of the plate.
5. Crumple red crepe paper into a ball and glue it as shown in the photo.
6. Use black and white stickers to make the eyes.

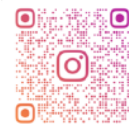
