MONTHLY ACTIVITY : MAKING THE OLYMPIC FLAG

Materials Needed:

- White construction paper
- Paper cups (one for each color of the Olympic rings)
- Paints in five colors (blue, yellow, black, green, red)
- Paper plates or palettes for mixing paint

1. Pour a small amount of each paint color onto the paper plates or palettes.
2. Dip the edge of each paper cup into a different color of paint.
3. Gently press the painted edge of the cup onto the white paper to create a ring shape. Repeat to create the five Olympic rings.

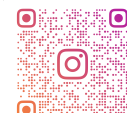
