Special In-School Program

P.E. Play

A physical activity time where children build gross motor skills through fun exercises and movement-based play.

Rythmique.

A rhythm-based music and movement activity that helps children develop coordination and expression. *3yrs only

Intellectual Play

A structured learning time that builds thinking skills through puzzles, matching, counting, and simple problem-solving.

*These programs are led by specialist instructors and conducted in Japanese. Children attending on these days will automatically join the in-school programs.

Japanese Inquiry: This is our inquiry time conducted in Japanese. Children explore the Japanese language and culture, and also revisit concepts they usually learn in English.

Cooking Class: A hands-on cooking class held at Keiyo Gas. Please note that children with certain allergies may be asked not to participate for safety reasons. Due to material preparation, the application deadline is Friday, November 28.

Agriculture Experience: A strawberry-care experience at the Loco Door facility, where children learn how strawberries are grown and how to take care of them.
